It was a great joy and blessing to be in St. Kitts in January to conduct a weekend Teaching to Transform conference.



Ninety-four people attended and they were so eager to squeeze in all the sessions that they could. During a Saturday session the attendees were given an opportunity to respond. A good number showed interest in assisting CEF in establishing a ministry, others were wanting to be prayer partners and some wanting further training. All of the responses were a great encouragement to Janet and

I as well as Margaret Smith, our new CEF missionary to St. Kitts who had just arrived in St. Kitts a week before the conference. Sonia, who had arranged the conference also arranged for other opportunities for Janet and I. We visited two primary schools where we did chapel and also two preschools. That Sunday was Children's Sunday and we had opportunity to share in the service and later that afternoon did a Children's Rally for seventy children. During the rally we praise God that one young girl received Christ. Since the conference more training has been conducted as well a Board training was conducted in April. We are expecting that it will not be long before St. Kitts will be officially open for CEF ministry.



## Minister of Education's invitation

**What an open door!!** CEF in St. Lucia has been invited by the Minister of Education to conduct, in ALL primary school in the country Religious Education. But how can we have enough teachers to go into all the schools to share the gospel was the question Claudette Adams the National Director asked herself.

St. Lucia in mid March is where you would have found me. Doing what I love most, helping in the multiplication of new Instructors. Nine ladies from St. Lucia and one CEF worker from Jamaica enrolled in the Instructor of Teachers Course. Level I. They worked very hard through the 60 hour course. Eight out of the group of ten work all day at jobs and came to class from 5:30—9:30 p.m. each day. The ladies were very committed and worked very hard.



Claudette Adams the National Director and Margaret Savory an instructor who works along side Claudette were candidates to become leadership Training Instructor and taught along side Janet and I. This team of new Instructors will now be equipped to



train teachers to go into the schools in St. Lucia so many children will be reached.

With St. Thomas being a territory of the USA we found that the public schools were not as open to the gospel as other parts of the Caribbean, which was sad to see. Pray with us that God will direct in the establishing of a CEF ministry in St. Thomas, St. Croix and St. John.
