In the first three weeks of December 2010, we were working with 5 day bible clubs in 5 different churches in the area of Masaya. We reached a total of 224 children of which 113 children accepted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. We are thankful with God because the 5 Day Bible Club Program allows us to reach new children each week who otherwise may not hear the Good News of Salvation.

In our reports we frequently talk about 5 day bible clubs, Bible clubs and Vacation bible school programs. The goal of the Vacation Bible school is to give a follow up to those children who are already attending bible clubs regularly. The main objective with the 5 day bible club is to establish clubs in churches who

don't work with children or don't have children's programs already established.

In the photo above, you will see the group we attended. In this church they have a total of 8 bible clubs. In attendance we had 202 children from the bible clubs as well as the Sunday school children. During the three day program, 49 children came to know Christ as their personal Saviour.

On this trip, we brought Phil and Suzanne Tyers to Puerto Morazán where CEF has contact with a church and its pastor. In Puerto we held a children's rally. We not only had children in attendance at the pier in Puerto Morazán but adults as well who enjoyed the presentation of puppets as well as the bible lesson. Approximately 150 people were in attendance. Phil and Suzanne also had the opportunity to bless the community giving out sandals and school bags. During that same visit we had the opportunity to visit some of the farmers and their shrimp beds to see how the small, isolated community makes its living.

This project was held in an Assemblies' of God Church in Jalapa, which is 3 hours north of the capital of Nicaragua. 20 teachers were present in the training course.

They spent time with the children making crafts and playing games after the CEF team presented a bible lesson. The two sisters had hands full the whole trip, after their one week visit, they had the chance of spending time with and making crafts for 250 children.

After the visit of my parents and their friends, the CEF team went right back to work. Our next challenge was our trip to Matagalpa. This is a city located in the central part of Nicaragua, about a 2 ½ h trip from Managua. God gave us the awesome privilege of training many teachers in this trip. We had a total of 84 teachers from 7 different churches and 9

denominations. Yesenia, Pastor Gustavo and I did the training. The other 3 people on our team did ministry with the children in different churches in Matagalpa. On this trip we had the blessing of reaching 348 children and 60 children gave their lives to Jesus.

After the trip was finished, we had been invited yet again to make another visit. The coordinators in the area would like us to do a training course for the children with “Children with Vision”. They hope to train a total of 120 kids to evangelize their friends and families. Please pray so that we can make the journey again on the 29th of April.
